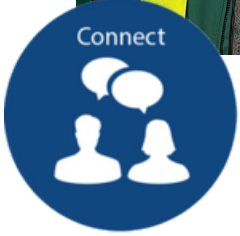
## A WARM WELCOME TO OUR NEWEST EMPLOYEES

## Next Generation!



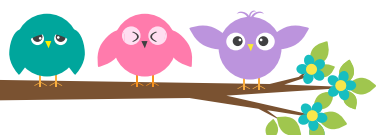
